TERMS OF REFERENCE & REQUEST FOR QUOTATIONS FROM SERVICE
PROVIDERS

TO REPLACE THE INLET VALVE ON THE NTSHINGWAYO RAW WATER PIPELINE
AT THE NGAGANE WATER PURIFICATION PLANT

1. Introduction:

As a bulk water supplier, it is the intention of uThukela Water to request quotations from suitable services providers to replace an inlet valve on the Ntshingwayo raw water pipeline at the Ngagane WPP.

2. Background:

uThukela Water assets and infrastructure include the Ngagane Water Purification Plant, raw & potable water pipelines and pump stations. As a Water Service Provider uThukela Water is responsible for the maintaining of the Water Purification Plants, pump stations and pipelines within its areas of responsibility.

3. Requirements:

The scope of work includes the supply and delivery of a new valve, removal of existing valve, installation of the new valve on the Ntshingwayo raw water pipeline. All materials, spares, labour, excavation and transportation are to be included in the quotation. Below is a table containing the scope of work.

<u>TABLE:</u>
Remove existing damaged inlet valve.
Supply and install new valve and gaskets.
Supply new bolts, nuts and washers.
Commission pipeline.
<u>Notes:</u> Quotations are to include: Removal of the existing inlet valve, supply, deliver and the installation of new inlet valve, all materials, spares, excavation, labour, equipment and transportation. All dimensions, sizes and valve type will be confirmed at the compulsory site meeting. The existing valve when removed, remains an asset of uThukela Water. uThukela Water to arrange for shutdown date.

- Bids will be adjudicated in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulation, 2022 pertaining to Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 5/2000, UTW SCM Policy and other applicable legislations, and will be based on 80/20 points system. Preference points will be awarded to service providers using their B-BBEE status level of contribution.
 - The municipal Entity reserves a right to accept all, some or none of the bids submitted, either wholly or in part and is not obliged to accept the lowest bid.
 - National Treasury General Conditions of the contracts are applicable.
